Learning objective: To develop a baseline of the environmental impact of the Whitstable Harbour& Boat Show, focused on CO2 emissions, waste (predominately plastic) and biodiversity. This baseline will enable better understanding of the impact of a show of this size and establish a set of recommendations to take forward for future shows.

Key Activities:

- Desk-based research to determine which metrics can help measure waste impact
- Both desk based and in-person research to develop a questionnaire which can be used both prior to and at the event
- Data analytics and interpretation understand current conservation challenges and opportunities looking forward

Learning Outcomes:

- Research: Use of desk-based and in-person research to design the methodology for data capture through the event questionnaire
- Skills Development: Interviewing stakeholders to ensure the questionnaire is relevant and correctly pitched to event attendees

- **Stakeholder engagement**: Gain understanding of importance of building stakeholder relationships and gaining their support
- **Data:** Processing and analysis, evaluating and reporting, report writing and proposal making.
- **Confidence Building**: Gaining confidence through following both the pre-prepared interview questions and asking probing, follow-up questions.
- **Presentations**: Practical examples of how to prepare and present back information, eg powerpoint, reports, etc
- Work Ethic: Understanding the importance of punctuality, responsibility, and professionalism
